

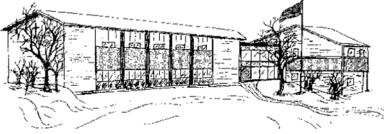

How to get onto RenWeb:

Go to www.renweb.com

On the right side is a Login button.

Choose Parent's Web on the pull down menu

The District Code is sa-mt

Your user name is your first initial and last name (unless you changed this at some point).

Your password is the one you used when you enrolled. If you are not sure what your password or user name is, you can request that it be emailed to you.

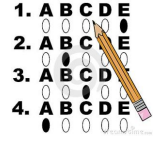

The PSAT will be given to students in **grades 10 and 11** on Wednesday, October 11, at St. Andrew School from 8:30 to 11:30am. This test is from College Board/National Merit Scholarship Corporation. Students who wish to take the test will be required to pay **\$16 due by Tuesday, October 10th**.

These tests are not mandatory. **Regular classes will be held for students not taking the test.**
